Prof. (Dr.) Atul Kumar Nasa currently serves as the Pro Vice-Chancellor at SGT University, Gurugram, where he continues to shape the future of pharmaceutical education and research. With over four decades of experience spanning pharmaceutical regulation, academia, industry, and administration, Dr. Nasa has left an indelible mark on the profession.

He began his academic journey with a Bachelor and Master of Pharmacy from Delhi University, followed by a Ph.D. in Pharmaceutical Sciences from Amity University.

His career includes pivotal roles such as Head of Office and Controlling & Licensing Authority at the Drugs Control Department, Government of NCT of Delhi, where he played a key role in policy formulation and enforcement.

Dr. Nasa has been an active member of various national committees under the Government of India, Government of Delhi, and the Pharmacy Council of India, contributing to the design and implementation of pharmaceutical policies. He also serves on the Governing and Academic Councils of multiple universities and colleges, reflecting his commitment to academic excellence.

His leadership, vision, and dedication to the pharmacy profession have earned him numerous accolades, culminating in the IPGA Lifetime Achievement Award 2025, recognizing his lifelong service and impact on pharmaceutical sciences and public health.

Dr. Manju Singh is a distinguished academic and researcher with over two decades of exemplary service in pharmaceutical sciences. Currently a Professor at the University Institute of Pharmacy, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, she has made pioneering contributions in pharmaceutical biotechnology, with a focus on autoimmune and inflammatory disorders, dermal drug delivery, and advanced experimental design.

Her prolific research output includes over 150 peer-reviewed publications, multiple book chapters, and six patents (three granted in India and two internationally, with two more filed). Her work has garnered significant academic recognition, with over 7,900 citations on Google Scholar (h-index: 38) and over 4,300 citations on Scopus (h-index: 34).

Dr. Singh has successfully led numerous research projects funded by premier agencies such as ICMR, DST, UGC, CGCOST, and IBITF, securing cumulative grants exceeding ₹1,296 lakhs. She also serves as a consultant to pharmaceutical start-ups, offering expertise in dosage form design and stability studies.

Her accolades include the DHR-ICMR International Young Indian Biochemical Scientist Award (2014–15), APTI Prof. C.J. Shishoo Award (2024), SPSR Women in Pharmaceutical Research Excellence Award (2025), and the Dr. Ambikanandan Misra Award (2022), among others. She has been consistently recognized among the world's top 2% scientists in Pharmacy and Pharmacology by Stanford University (2021–2025).

Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow, and holds the position of Associate Dean (Pharmacy).

A prominent figure in national academic governance, Dr. Ved is a Member of the Central Council of the Pharmacy Council of India, representing the University Grants Commission. He also serves on the Boards of Studies across multiple universities and holds key leadership roles as National Joint Secretary of APTI and Executive Committee Member of IPGA.

Dr. Ved's research spans Pharmaceutical Chemistry, with expertise in Phytochemistry, Ethnopharmacology, Microwave-Assisted Organic Synthesis, and Medicinal Chemistry. His work on natural products has led to discoveries with hepatoprotective, antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, CNS, and anticancer properties. He has mentored numerous Ph.D. and postgraduate scholars, fostering a culture of innovation and academic excellence.

His prolific output includes over 100 research publications, 6 books, and 12 book chapters. He holds 16 patents—8 national and 8 international—demonstrating his commitment to translational research and intellectual property development.

Prof. Gaurav Kaithwas is a pioneering pharmaceutical scientist whose research bridges molecular pharmacology, translational drug delivery, and therapeutic innovation. Honored with the Research Excellence Award 2025, he has made landmark contributions to hypoxia-driven tumor biology, siRNA-based therapeutics, and metabolic reprogramming in cancer chemoprevention.

With over ₹3 crore in extramural funding from agencies such as SERB, UGC, DHR, MOFPI, and Merck, Dr. Kaithwas has led multiple high-impact projects. His work has resulted in three awarded patents and five recent applications, focusing on plant-derived lipid therapeutics and siRNA-based gene regulation. He has published more than 110 research papers in top-tier journals, holds an H-index of 35, and is listed among the top 2% scientists globally by Stanford University (2024).

Beyond research, Dr. Kaithwas serves as Director of the University Sophisticated Instrumentation Centre and Nodal Officer of the National Insight Centre for Education Portal.

His leadership has elevated BBAU's Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences to a prestigious NIRF Rank of 19 (2023). A mentor to numerous postgraduate and doctoral scholars,

Dr. Kaithwas is celebrated for his commitment to ethical research, innovation with societal impact, and capacity building through advanced training workshops.

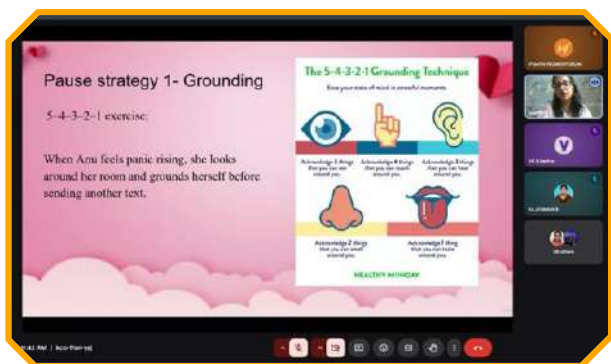

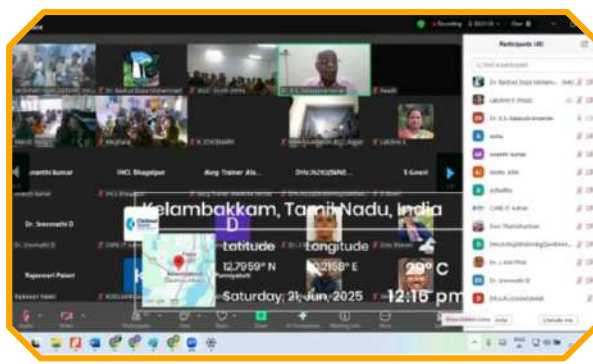

"A Sneak Peek into Genotoxicity Testing: What Happens Before Clinical Trials?" Theme: Where Science Meets Safety:

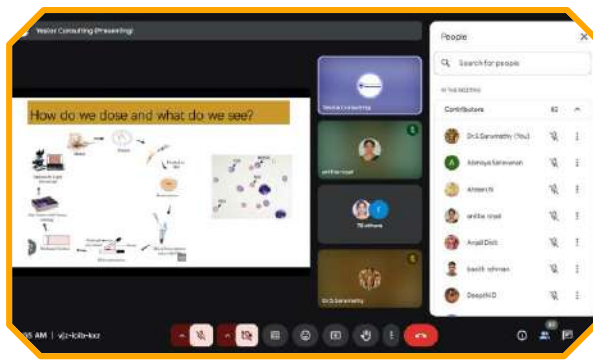
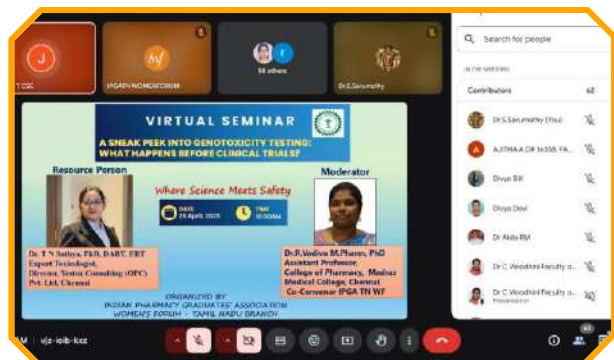
