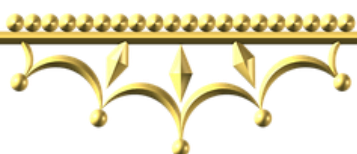

Dr. G. Selvaraj is a Pharmacy Graduate from the reputed Madurai Medical College, he qualified Master of Business Administration from Bharathiyar University, then completed his Bachelor of Law and Master of Law courses, additionally he qualified Diploma in Taxation Law (Sales Tax and Income Tax), and in this learning eagerness, he also qualified his Ph.D., Doctorate from Vinayaga Deemed University. Dr, Selvaraj has proved himself as a continuous learner and enthusiastic officer in his career.

He served in Pharmaceutical Industry for four years and then joined to the Drugs Control Department of Government of Tamilnadu as Drugs Inspector in 1984 and served in various capacities before his retirement in 2013 as Director of Drugs Control of the State to complete his 29 years of services till superannuation with remarkable achievements.

Ltd., USV Ltd. and Elder Pharmaceuticals Ltd in manufacturing of tablets, capsules, ointment and liquid orals. He was nominated by MPSC for the Post of Drugs Inspector, Food and Drug Administration, Maharashtra State in 1992 and was subsequently promoted as Assistant Commissioner (Drugs). During his tenure of 26 years in FDA, Maharashtra, he worked in Intelligence Branch, WHO-GMP certification cell and in District with industrial belts like Pune, Thane and Raigad. 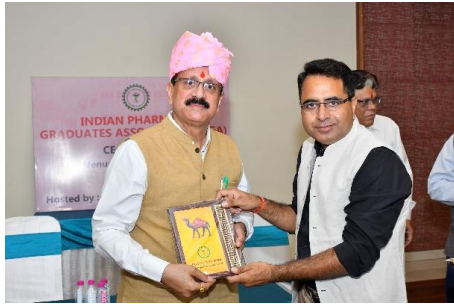

Being a major public place, more than 2000 people were benefited through this event held in the morning session (6 am to 9 am) on World Pharmacists' Day 2024.



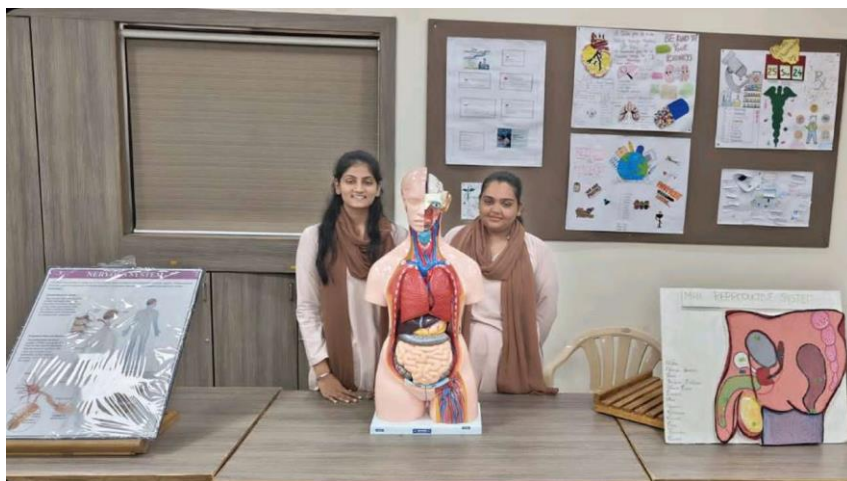

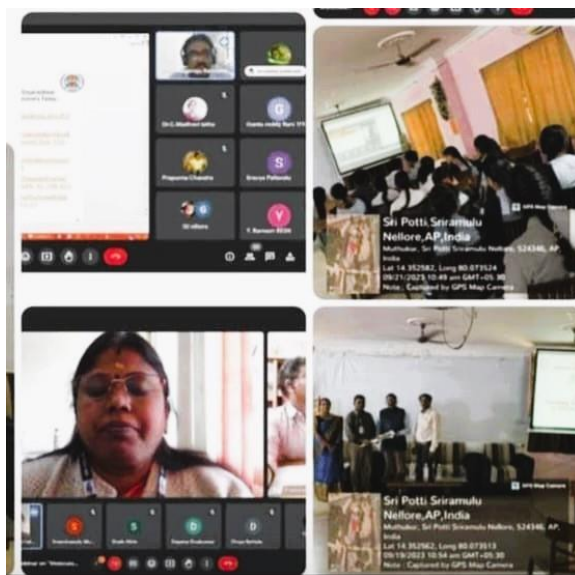

#### **VISION:**

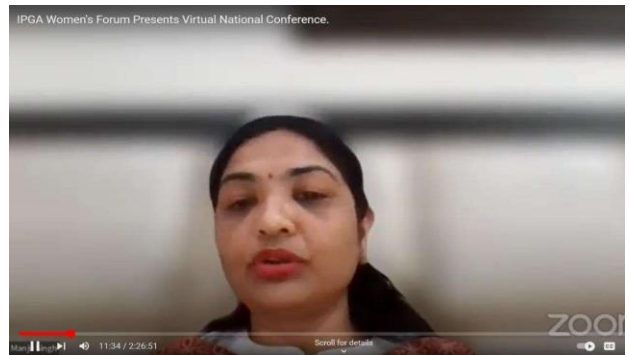
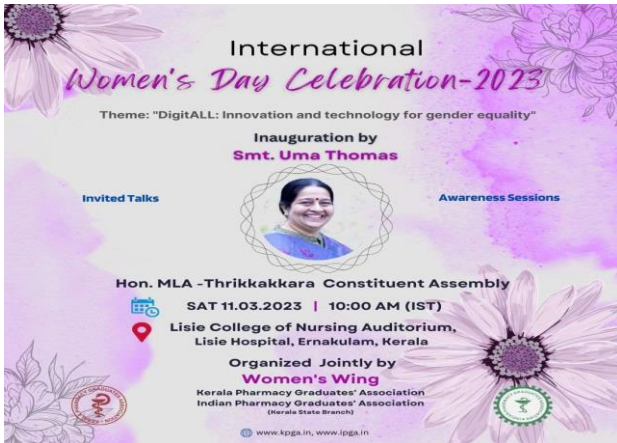
- ❖ To provide a common platform to women pharmacy graduates to improve their responsiveness on their opinions and apprehensions.

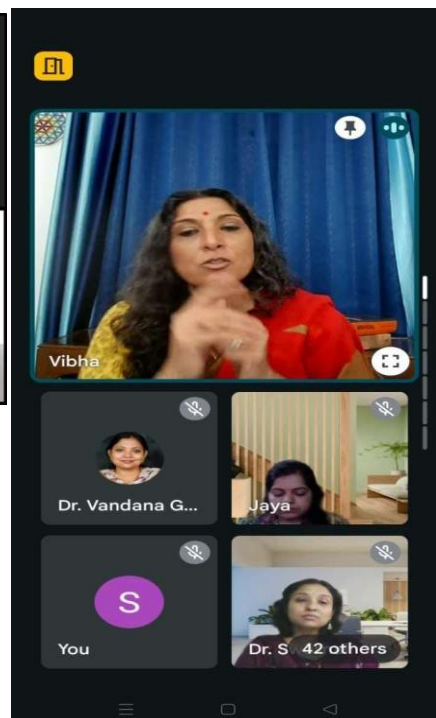
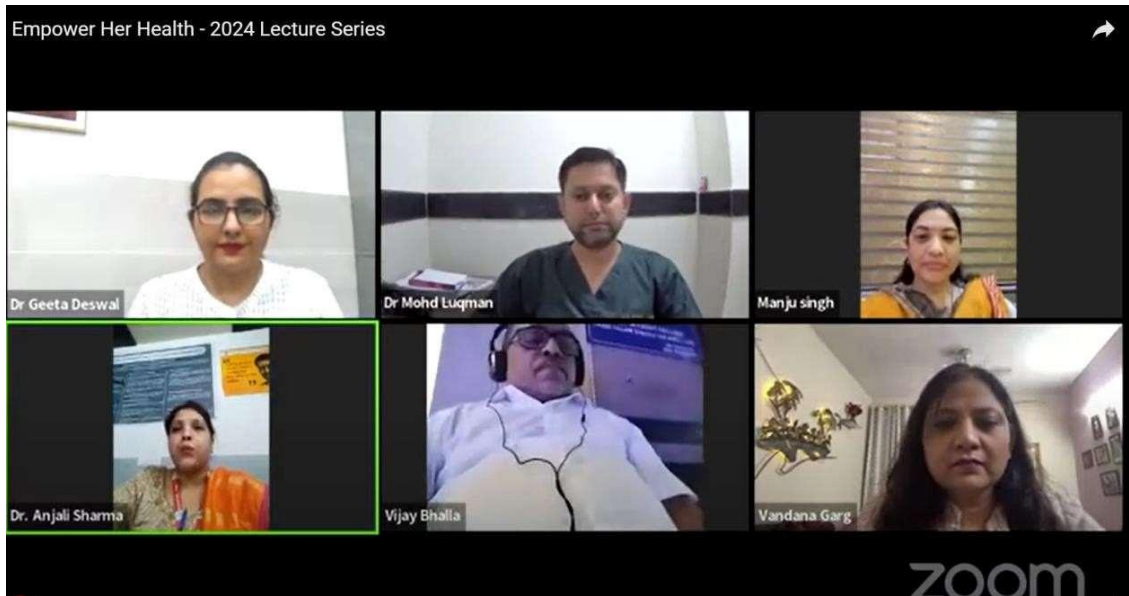
